



Highways Meeting between County Cllr David Smith ; Tim Heminsley, Community Infrastructure Liasion Manager, Lichfield District Council ; PSCSO Andrea Horsnall & Shenstone Parish Council Thursday February 8th 2018.

A meeting took place on the aforementioned date to discuss a number of Highways issues in Shenstone, Stonnall & Little Aston . One of these items was the growing issue of problem parking around Shenstone Station & the knock on effects to side roads in the village.

Cllr Smith said *“This is a strategic issue with the new Crossrail operators and Network Rail. They say that they are going to invest in stations so the Leader of the Council has had this problem put on the agenda for the next joint board meeting”*

Cllr Neil Perry reiterated the extent of the problem and the number of emails, calls & personal visits to the office expressing concern. PCSO Andrea Horsnall was in agreement but stressed that the Parking advisory notices she issues is the limit to her power of enforcement. After some discussion, it was agreed that some form of public consultation must take place & Tim Heminsley confirmed that he will come up with a plan re a general public consultation within the next four weeks.

Once this plan is agreed & approved, the Parish Council will share the details with residents.
