SHENSTONE PARISH COUNCIL BURIAL GROUND - FEES FIXED AND SETTLED UNDER SECTION 34 OF THE BURIAL ACT 1852 AND CEMETERY REGULATIONS

The fees set out below apply where the person to be interred or in respect of whom the right is granted is, or immediately before his death was, an inhabitant or parishioner of the Parish of Shenstone, or in the case of a still-born child, where the parents (or one of them) are, or at the time of the interment were, such inhabitants or parishioners.

INTERMENT FEES

	Fee from 1 st April 2017
A child whose age at the time of death did not exceed 12 years	Free of charge
A person whose age at the time of death exceeded 12 years	£250
Cremated remains	£200

EXCLUSIVE RIGHT OF BURIAL (INCLUDING THE COST OF THE DEED OF GRANT)

For the exclusive right of burial in an earthen grave 9' by 4' (274cm x 122cm)	£200
For the exclusive right of burial of cremated remains in an earthen grave 3' x 4' (92cm x 122cm)	£200
Re-opening of existing plot	£150

FEES FOR THE PLACEMENT OF A MEMORIAL

	Fees from 1 st April 2017
A stone not exceeding 61cm x 61cm & no higher than 35.56cm	£100
One or two vases (see detailed specifications below)	£75
First inscription	FOC
Additional inscription on existing stone	£25

MEMORIAL REGULATIONS

These regulations are not intended to be unnecessarily restrictive. They are made for the sole purpose of enabling the cemetery to be maintained in a neat and orderly manner

The Parish Council will provide a marker for each plot

NON-RESIDENTS

Non-residents may be considered subject to meeting with certain criteria

If approval is given fees will be charged at a rate double to those of local residents
