SHENSTONE PARISH COUNCIL BURIAL GROUND

FEES FIXED AND SETTLED UNDER SECTION 34 OF THE BURIAL ACT 1852 AND CEMETERY REGULATIONS

The fees set out below apply where the person to be interred or in respect of whom the right is granted is, or immediately before his/her death was, an inhabitant or parishioner of the Parish of Shenstone, or in the case of a still-born child, where the parents (or one of them) are, or at the time of the interment were, such inhabitants or parishioners.

INTERMENT FEES

	Fee from 1 st January 2020
A child whose age at the time of death did not exceed 12 years	Free of charge
A person whose age at the time of death exceeded 12 years	£600
Cremated remains	£250

EXCLUSIVE RIGHT OF BURIAL (INCLUDING THE COST OF THE DEED OF GRANT)

	Fee from 1 st January 2020
For the exclusive right of burial in an earthen grave 9' by 4' / 274 x 122cm	£1000
For the exclusive right of burial of cremated remains in an earthen grave 3' by 4' / 92 x 122 cm	£750
Re-opening of existing plot	£300

NB: THAT PRIOR TO INTERNMENT THE PLOT LOCATION MUST HAVE BEEN CONFIRMED BY THE REGISTRAR

- 1 Fees charged by this Council do not include the costs for grave digging
- 2 Subject to certain criteria the fees for non-residents of the Parish of Shenstone may be considered, and if approval granted the fees will be charged at a double rate for those quoted for local residents

<u>FEES FOR THE PLACEMENT OF A MEMORIAL</u>	Fees from 1 st April 2017
A stone not exceeding 61cm x 61cm and no higher than 35.56cm	£200
One or two vases	£75
First inscription	Free of Charge
Additional inscriptions on existing stones	£25
<u>MEMORIAL REGULATIONS</u>	

These regulations are not intended to be unnecessarily restrictive. They are made for the sole purpose of enabling the cemetery to be maintained in a neat and orderly manner.

The Parish Council will provide a marker for each plot

NON-RESIDENTS

Non-residents may be considered subject to meeting with certain criteria / if approval from the Council is given the fees charged will be at double the rate of those of local residents
