On behalf of the Cooper Room Management Committee, I would like to confirm that the Trustees are willing to look into raising the funds needed to cover the expense of the repairs required to the building.

During 2018/2019, the Committee had raised funds to start modernising The Cooper Room, windows were replaced, new tables and chairs were purchased and equipment in the kitchen had been brought up to date. It was our intention to continue improving the facilities when the Covid-19 situation meant that it was necessary to close. It has been a difficult 2 years but recently interest has started to increase and as well as some of our regular users returning, we are getting weekend bookings again.

I am grateful to Councillor David Salter for taking the time to produce the report for the meeting of the Trustees on Wednesday 19th January 2022.
